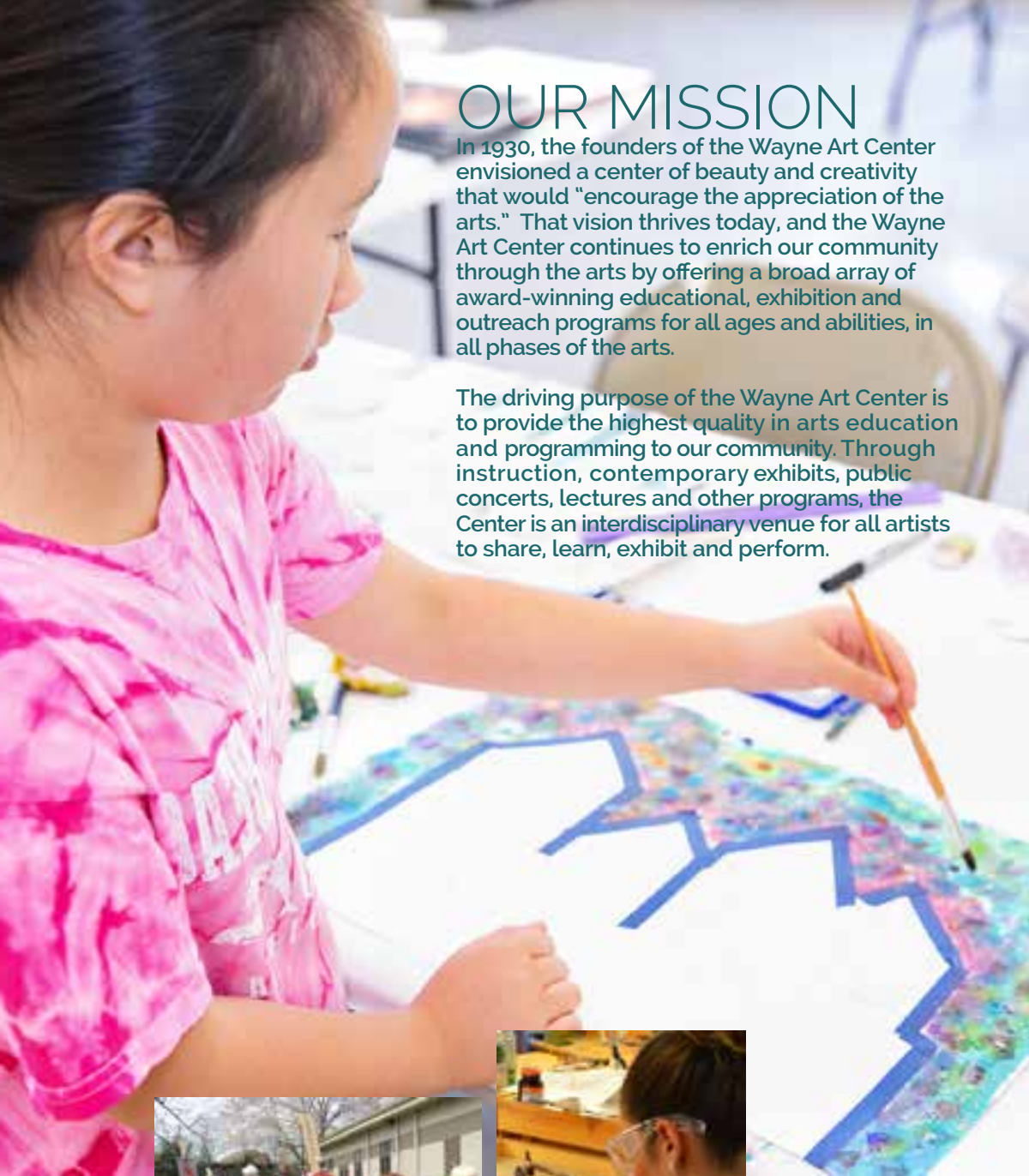

OUTREACH

THE TIMOTHY SCHOOL *Collaborating with Students*
