Minimum Qualifications:

- All volunteers must be entering 9th grade or higher by the Fall of 2018.
- Volunteer should possess a desire and ability to work indoors with children in a classroom/studio setting.
- Must commit to schedule.
- Must be a positive member of the team who is able to accept supervision and guidance.
- Adaptability, integrity and commitment are integral.

Duties:

- Volunteer must commit to *at least two entire weeks* of Summer Art Camp (Monday – Friday).
- Each volunteer will assist campers and teachers in WAC's Summer Art Camp programs to help create a safe and fun environment.
- Volunteer should provide leadership and share enthusiasm while participating in camp activities.
- Volunteer must be helpful through the full time committed on schedule.
- Volunteer must uphold all camp rules and set a good example for campers.
- Volunteer should enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures.
